	its habitat. (Animals are handled with care – and guides cause no harm to the animals).

	• The Monkey Forest is open to guests visits, always in the company of a facility professional.

	houses. Arrival at The Meeting of the Waters by 11h30 am.		
	• The Meeting of the Waters is the spectacle formed by the merging waters of Negro and		
	Solimões Rivers. From this point on it becomes the famous Amazon running all the way to		
	the Atlantic Ocean. The waters of the two rivers run alongside, not mixing, for about 12 km.
