ITINERARY

DAY 1	Arrival - Amman (D)
	Meet and assist by our representative at Queen Alia Airport and transfer to your hotel in Amman. dinner and overnight in Amman
DAY 2	Amman - Madaba - Mt. Nebo - Amman (B,L,D)
	After breakfast, drive to Madaba (the city of Mosaics), Greek Orthodox Church of St. George Madaba a capital city of Madaba Governorate of Jordan, which has a population of about 60.000. Madaba is the fifth most populous town in Jordan. It is best known for its Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics, especially a large Byzantine-era mosaic map of Palestine and the Nile delta. Madaba is located 30 miles south-west of the capital Amman. Proceed to Mount Nebo : The trip south of Amman along the 5,000 years old King's Highway is one of the most memorable journeys in the Holy Land, passing through a string of ancient sites of Jordan, the memorial of Moses, and the presumed site of the prophet's death and burial place. From a platform in front of the church one can enjoy a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. After lunch back to your hotel for leisure and fee time.
DAY 3	Amman - Allenby - Cana - Nazareth. (B,L,D)
	After breakfast, transfer to Allenby border to cross to Israel. Complete the customs & emigration formalities. Enter into Israel, lunch at Restaurant, then Visit Nazareth, the Basilica of the Annunciation built over We also stop by Joseph's workshop, then Visit Cana where Jesus performed his first Miracle, changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Check-in hotel, dinner. Overnight stay in Nazareth
DAY 4	Sea of Galilee- Capernaum- Nazareth- Bethlehem, (B,L,D)
	After Breakfast, check-out Hotel, visit Mount Tabor, visit Capernaum, we stop at Tabgha - and the expressive church of the Beatitudes, we drive through the landscapes of Galilee and later for a ride in a replica of a Galilean fishing boat of that time, the flat rock known as Mensa Christy, Christ's table to commemorate this event, the lunch. We visit Yardenit on the Jordan River, the traditional Baptismal site, and then visit Jericho where we stop and view Qarantal, the traditional Mount of Temptation and Sycamore Tree, Proceed to Bethlehem. Check-in hotel, dinner. Overnight stay at Bethlehem.

DAY 5	<p style="text-align: center;">Old City of Jerusalem – Golgotha – Wailing Wall (B,L,D)</p> <p>After breakfast we drive to Bethlehem and see the Church of the Nativity, and below it the stable-cave of Jesus Birth, also visit Omar mosque behind the church, Continue to Hebron and visit Al Haram Al Ibrahimy in the way back we visit Makam Al NabiYounos in Halhul. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem</p>
DAY 6	<p style="text-align: center;">Jerusalem – Jericho –Dead Sea– Jerusalem (B ,L , D)</p> <p>Breakfast, and then proceed to the pools of Beit Hasda, And from there we take the Via Dolorosa Follow the 14 Stations of the Cross to Golgotha, The last 5 Stations of the Cross are inside the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Visit Cenacle – Last Supper Room, the tomb of King David and Then we go to the Jewish quarter to the Wailing Wall, and visit Alaqsa, Lunch & Proceed to Dead Sea, make a brief stop at a private beach and take the opportunity to float in the salty water. Proceed to Bethany. Visit Lazarus’s Tomb then to Ein Karim. Back to hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at Bethlehem</p>
DAY 7	<p style="text-align: center;">Mount of Olives-Gethsemane-Bethlehem (B ,L , D)</p> <p>After breakfast we proceed to Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit sanctuaries of Pater Nester Ascension. Walk along the Palm Sunday road down to the chapel of Dominoes Flevitand and Garden of Gethsemane, Visit the Basilica of agony and Tomb of St. Mary. We also will visit the Church of St. Peter of Gallicantu, and then visit the traditional house of high priest, Caiaphas, Then proceed to Bethlehem to visit the Shepherds field .lunch. We then visit the Church of Nativity and the City of David, and then we visit Milk Grotto. Dinner and overnight stay Bethlehem.</p>
DAY 8	<p style="text-align: center;">Bethlehem -Taba – Sinai (B ,L , D)</p> <p>Breakfast at hotel. Check-out Hotel. Proceed to Taba. On the way View Qumran caves, view statue of Loth’s wife & we shall drop by the Red Sea for few minutes. Arrive to Taba. Finish the Customs and Emigration formalities at the Israel side, Enter into Egypt. Complete the emigration and customs formalities. Then lunch and Check-in hotel. Dinner and Overnight at hotel.</p>
DAY 9	<p style="text-align: center;">Taba – Sinai – Cairo (B ,L , D)</p> <p>After Breakfast, Then proceed to Sinai (Exodus 19). View the beautiful and historical Sinai Mountains. Visit St. Catherine Monastery. Set beneath the mountain where Moses is said to have received the Ten Commandments. Saint Catherine Monastery has been one of the world’s great centers of religious pilgrimage for over fifteen centuries. Within its imposing walls rests a citadel like no other, incredibly rich in important religious and historical structures. Among its treasures is a library of ancient manuscripts and icons second only to the Vatican's itself, and a 6th century church reputed to lie directly on the site of the Burning Bush (Exodus 3:1-6). Quite simply, the monastery is a defining feature of the Holy Land. After Breakfast. Then proceed to Cairo we cross the famous Suez Canal. Arrive to Cairo. Proceed to restaurant for Dinner. Then proceed to Hotel. Overnight at Hotel</p>
DAY 10	<p style="text-align: center;">Cairo(B ,L, D)</p> <p>After Breakfast, Check-out hotel. Proceed on a visit to Pyramids, The Great Pyramid of Giza (also called the Pyramid of Khufu and the Pyramid of Cheops) is the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza Necropolis bordering what is now El Giza, Egypt, and in a historical irony is the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World and the only one that survives substantially intact. It is believed the pyramid was built as a tomb for fourth dynasty Egyptian Pharaoh Khufu (Cheops in Greek) and constructed over a 20 year period concluding around 2551 BC. The Great Pyramid was the tallest man-made structure in the world for over 3,800 years Sphinx and the old churches of Cairo. Visit Egyptian Museum. Lunch. Then we visit perfume and papyrus factory and then we proceed to Cairo International airport to board flight</p>
