

4D3N JOURNEY TO THE LAND OF PEACEFUL DRAGON PARO - THIMPHU - PARO

VALID UNTIL: 31 MARCH 2020

Itinerary:

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	ARRIVE PARO, TRANSFER TO THIMPHU (55 KM, 1:30 HOURS DRIVE) (L/D)		
	• The flight to Paro on a clear day is one of the most spectacular of all mountain flights. One can see Mt. Everest, Kanchenjunga, Makalu and other peaks in Bhutan such as Chomolhari, Jichu Drake and Tseringghang. The firstgift from Bhutan will be cool, clean fresh air as you step out of the aircraft. You will be received by ourrepresentative and transfer to Thimphu. On arrival in Thimphu, check into the hotel.		
DAY 4	Afternoon, proceed to visit National Memorial Chorten: a monument for world peace and prosperity. Thepaintings and statues inside the monument provide a deep insight into Buddhist philosophy.		

DAY 1

- Buddhist philosophy.
- Later visitTrashichhoedzong (opens until 4 pm): This impressive fortress/monastery houses Secretariat building, thethrone room of His Majesty, the King and various government offices. It is also the summer residence of ChiefAbbot and central monk body. Afterwards, drive to Buddha Point (Kuenselphodrang).
- You can pay yourobeisance and offer prayers to the Buddha, the largest statue in the country and then walk around and take aglimpse of the valley. Overnight at the hotel in Thimphu (Altitude 2400m).

## THIMPHU - PARO (B/L/D)

DAY 2

- Morning after breakfast, proceed sightseeing of National Library, which holds a vast collection of ancientBuddhist texts and manuscripts, some dating back several hundred years, as well as modern academic booksmainly on Himalayan culture and religion: (Closed on Weekends). Also visit nearby Institute for ZorigChusum: Commonly known as Arts & Crafts School or Painting School (closed on Sat, Sun & GovernmentHolidays), the Institute offers a six-year course on the 13 traditional arts and crafts of Bhutan. On a visit, onecan see students learning the various skills taught at the school.
- Textile Museum: With the opening of Textile Museum, Bhutanese textile have reached new heights as one of the most visible distinct art form. (Closed on Sundays). Followed by a visit to 'Simply Bhutan' - an exclusive project under the Bhutan Youth Development Fund. It is a living Museum and Studio encapsulating the culturalheritage of the Bhutanese people. The infrastructure portrays ancient Bhutanese architecture which is beinglost to modernization.

After lunch drive to Paro Zamar Travel & Tours SdnBhd (1013531-V / KPL LN: 6946)

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In the afternoon in Paro, proceed to visit Ta Dzong (CLOSED ON GOVT. HOLIDAYS): once a watchtower, builtto defend RinpungDzong during inter-valley wars of the 17th century, Ta Dzong was inaugurated as Bhutan's National Museum in 1968. It holds fascinating collection of art, relics, religious Thangkha paintings and Bhutan's exquisite postage stamps. The museum circular shape augments its varied collection displayed overseveral floors. Afterwards, walk down a hillside trail to visit RinpungDzong, which has a long and fascinating history. Builtin 1646 by ShabdrungNgawangNamgyal, the first spiritual and temporal ruler of Bhutan, the Dzong houses themonastic body of Paro, the office of the Dzongda (district administrative head) and Thrimpon (judge) of Parodistrict. The approach to the Dzong is through a traditional covered bridge called NemiZam. A walk throughthe bridge, over a stone inlaid path, offers a good view of the architectural wonder of the Dzong as well as lifearound it. It is also the venue of Paro Tshechu, held once a year in the spring. Overnight at the hotel in Paro.(Altitude 2200m) PARO (B/L/D) Morning excursion to Taktshang Lhakhang (approx. 5 hrs walking excursion): perched on the side of a cliff900m above the Paro Valley floor, it is undoubtedly one of the most famous of Bhutan's monasteries. Lore hasit that Guru Rinpoche arrived here on the back of a tigress and meditated at this monastery thus the name'Tiger's Nest'. This site has been recognized as a most sacred place and visited by ShabdrungNgawangNamgyal in 1646 and now visited by all DAY 3 Bhutanese at least once in their lifetime. On 19 April, 1998, a fireseverely damaged the main structure of building but now this Bhutanese jewel has been restored to its originalsplendor. On the drive towards Paro town en route visiting Kyichu Lhakhang, one of the oldest monasteries of the Kingdom reflecting introduction of Buddhism in Bhutan. Dinner and Overnight at the hotel in Paro. **DEPART PARO (B)** After early breakfast at the hotel, drive to the airport for flight to your onward destination. DAY 4 Our representative will help you with exit formalities and then bid you farewell.
